- Most pediatric guidelines suggest first introducing single ingredient foods between 4 to 6 months of age, with one new food every 3 to 5 days • There is no need to delay acidic fruits (berries, tomatoes, citrus fruits) and vegetables that may cause a perioral rash or irritation since they do not usually result in systemic reactions
